Backup's sealing orings.

Each backup is equipped with two orings that seal the body to the head.

Orings' condition should be checked thoroughly before and after each dive.

They should be clean - any dust, sand or mud should be carefully removed with a soft tissue.

Cut or torn orings need immediate replacing. If any of the orings become loose and prone to moving out of the groove when twisting the body to the head, it needs replacing as well.

Sealing orings should be greased with pure vaseline (petroleum jelly) or other non-invasive grease.

Dry orings do not work as they should and do not seal the backup properly.

Orings should be replaced only for the ones provided by light-for-me or authorised distributors. Do not replace orings for some random ones, even if they look like the genuine ones.
